If you've got an idea, send us a pitch of no more than **300 words** outlining the concept. Tell us who you are, why the story is important and provide examples of your writing.

Concept

We want to hear about exciting and inspirational stories that explore **outside-the-box ideas** and **diverse perspectives** which aren't always seen or represented.

Is there a designer, photographer, artist, writer, illustrator, collective or entrepreneur who you look up to? If so, what's their **approach** to creative work, education, or internships? Is there a **problem** you have experienced or a change you would like to see made in the creative industries or education system? Do you have some **advice** for young creatives to help them navigate their careers that goes beyond generic platitudes? We want to hear about it and explore it with you.

Approach

- Our stories are about starting **productive discussions** and empowering young creatives not dragging names through the mud.
- Focussing on your personal experiences is an option but not a necessity. You could use your experiences as the starting point for an investigation rather than as the central focus of the pitch.
- **Don't feel limited** to the creative industries for your subject matter. While they are our starting point, inspirational approaches to work, learning and fostering diversity occur in all industries.
